1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1.1. The Scientific Center "International Center for Computer Science and Artificial Intelligence" (ICCSAI) is a voluntary association of higher education students, early-career researchers, and employees of Yuriy Fedkovych Chernivtsi National University.

1.2. ICCSAI was established taking into account mutual obligations under partnership and cooperation agreements between Yuriy Fedkovych Chernivtsi National University and leading foreign higher education institutions, laboratories and research centers, and scientific publishers.

1.3. The main purpose of ICCSAI is to improve the scientific and professional levels of specialists in the field of information technologies, in particular computer science and artificial intelligence, software and computer engineering, etc., at Yuriy Fedkovych Chernivtsi National University.

1.4. In its activities, ICCSAI is guided by these Regulations, the Charter of the University, and the current legislation of Ukraine.

1.5. The research activities of ICCSAI are coordinated (strategic recommendations) by the International Scientific Committee composed of:

1.6. ICCSAI does not have the status of a legal entity and is not a structural subdivision of the University.

1.7. The English name of ICCSAI is International Center for Computer Science and Artificial Intelligence (ICCSAI).

1.8. ICCSAI is located in Room 115, Building 8, and is affiliated with the Educational and Research Institute of Physical, Technical and Computer Sciences.

2. PURPOSE, OBJECTIVES AND AREAS OF ACTIVITY

2.1. The purpose of ICCSAI is:

- to promote the improvement of the scientific and professional levels of specialists in the field of information technologies, in particular computer science and artificial intelligence, software and computer engineering, etc., by holding scientific and professional conferences, workshops, seminars, and trainings;
- to create favorable conditions for publishing scientific articles by academic staff of Yuriy Fedkovych Chernivtsi National University in international scientific journals, including journals indexed in Scopus, Web of Science, DBLP, and other databases, in particular within the framework of agreements already signed with publishers;
- to develop cooperation between Yuriy Fedkovych Chernivtsi National University and leading foreign higher education institutions, laboratories and research centers in the scientific, technical, and educational areas in the field of information technologies, in particular computer science and artificial intelligence, software and computer engineering, etc.

2.2. The scope of ICCSAI activities includes:

- organizing scientific and professional conferences, workshops, seminars, and trainings in cooperation with international partners;
- providing organizational support for the publication of scientific articles in the field of information technologies by academic staff of Yuriy Fedkovych Chernivtsi National University in international scientific journals indexed in Scopus, Web of Science, DBLP, and other databases, in particular within the framework of agreements already signed with publishers;
- coordinating the activities of the subdivisions of Yuriy Fedkovych Chernivtsi National University in their cooperation with international partners in the field of information technologies;
- international scientific and technical activities.

3. MEMBERSHIP IN ICCSAI

3.1. A member of ICCSAI may be a student, a postgraduate student, an early-career researcher and/or an employee of Yuriy Fedkovych Chernivtsi National University who recognizes these Regulations and is actively engaged in scientific, educational, technical, and organizational activities in the field of information technologies, within the framework defined by these Regulations.

3.2. Admission to ICCSAI membership is carried out by the Coordinator on the basis of a written application addressed to the Coordinator.

3.3. An ICCSAI member has the right to:

- participate in ICCSAI meetings;
- participate in the discussion of all matters related to ICCSAI activities;
- freely express their views and proposals for improving ICCSAI operations;
- participate in all events held by ICCSAI and initiate their organization;

- withdraw from ICCSAI membership on the basis of a written application.

3.4. An ICCSAI member is obliged to:

- comply with these Regulations;
- carry out scientific, research, scientific and technical, and organizational activities;
- take an active part in ICCSAI activities;
- follow the instructions of the ICCSAI Coordinator;
- take due care of the property of the University and the property used by ICCSAI.

3.5. Termination of membership in ICCSAI.

3.5.1. An ICCSAI member may be excluded from ICCSAI membership:

- at their own request;
- in case of violation of these Regulations;
- in case of their expulsion from among students and/or postgraduate students, or termination of employment at the University.

3.5.2. The issue of excluding an ICCSAI member is decided by the ICCSAI Coordinator unilaterally.

4. SUPPORTING THE ACTIVITIES

4.1. ICCSAI is affiliated with the Educational and Research Institute of Physical, Technical and Computer Sciences and may use the material and technical base of this structural unit in its activities.

4.2. Coordination and supervision of ICCSAI activities are carried out by the Head of the Department of Computer Science, Prof. Yurii Oleksandrovysh Ushenko (Coordinator).

4.3. To support ICCSAI activities, the structural subdivisions of Yuriy Fedkovych Chernivtsi National University, within their powers and duties, facilitate the creation of the necessary conditions.

4.4. ICCSAI activities are funded by:

- contributions from sponsors, organizations, and individuals from Ukraine and abroad, etc.;
- contributions from scientific societies and organizations.

4.5. ICCSAI financial proceeds may be spent in accordance with the approved budget of Yuriy Fedkovych Chernivtsi National University (if such proceeds are available).

4.6. The procedure for using ICCSAI property is determined by the ICCSAI Coordinator.

5. TERMINATION OF ICCSAI ACTIVITIES

5.1. Termination of ICCSAI activities is carried out by an order of the Rector or the First Vice-Rector.

5.2. Amendments and additions to these Regulations are made by an order of the Rector or the First Vice-Rector.
